ACT and Praxis CORE Comparisons

These data represent the ACT and Praxis Core scores of 152 teacher candidates. Lists of teacher candidates were gathered from Introduction to Education courses between Spring 2016 and the Spring 2018. The Director of Academic Research at VCSU was able to pull the ACT data available. While data on 152 candidates is beneficial to study, the overall mean and median scores is likely higher. The limitation of the data set is that it primarily consists of on-campus VCSU teacher candidates whose ACT scores were in the VCSU system. Transfer students from Wyoming and NDSU are not required to share their ACT scores for admission to VCSU. NDSU students need an ACT of 21 or higher to be accepted to the institution, hence the overall ACT would likely be higher if the scores for another 100 or more teacher candidates from the NDSU campus were included.

Cumulative GPA also has a significant correlation with the ACT and Praxis Core exams, but the ACT and Praxis Core exams do not have a significant relationship with student teacher final evaluation mean scores. **Only GPA also has a significant relationship with student teacher final evaluations**.

A significant correlation exists between overall mean scores for teacher candidates and cumulative GPA. Individual results for student teachers continue to vary. Almost every faculty member can name a teacher candidate with a lower GPA who excelled during his or her student teaching experience, and almost every faculty member can think of an honor student who did not shine during student teaching. Examples that are contrary to the data exist. The overall data continue to indicate a significant correlation (p<.01) exists between GPA and cooperating teacher final evaluations. As a whole, candidates with higher GPAs have received higher ratings from cooperating teachers.
